

On January 24, 2003, the Receiver filed the Contempt Motion, alleging, that Terry L. Dowdell and others had, *inter alia*, directly and indirectly violated this Court's Asset Freeze orders.

Hearing was held February 5, 2003, in which the Receiver represented to the Court that counsel for the Receiver, the SEC and counsel for Mary Dowdell and Rebecca Dowdell needed additional time to resolve the issues related to the contempt. On February 19, 2003, the Court entered an order continuing the show cause for up to fourteen days to a date to be set by the Clerk of the Court.

On June 4, 2003, the Court entered Final Judgement Orders against Mary Dowdell and Rebecca Dowdell that expressly incorporate the Consent and Stipulations of Mary Dowdell and Rebecca Dowdell, respectively. The Consent and Stipulations of Mary Dowdell and Rebecca Dowdell required the Receiver to withdraw the motions for civil contempt against the respective party upon execution of the Consent and Stipulation and entry of the Final Judgment, but the parties disputed whether the terms and conditions in those orders required disclosure of the amount and source funds paid for certain legal fees.

On October 14, 2003, the Receiver filed the *Receiver's Motion to Compel Production of Requested Disclosures*.

By Order entered November 24, 2003, the Court resolved the disputes with respect to the amount and source funds paid for certain legal fee. Accordingly,
