Before the court is the Receiver's Notice of Filing of Financial Statements and Motion to File Under Seal, filed January 16, 2004. The Receiver files these financial statements in compliance with an earlier order of the court. Having carefully weighed the First Amendment right of access to public documents against the need to protect the specific information about receivership assets, the court finds the Receiver's motion to seal to be adequately supported. *See In Re Knight Pub'n Co.*, 743 F.2d 231 (4th Cir. 1984).
