Before the court is the Receiver's Notice of Filing of Financial Statements and Motion to File Under Seal, filed April 15, 2004. The Receiver files these financial statements in compliance with an earlier order of the court. Having carefully weighed the First Amendment right of access to public documents against the need to protect the specific information about receivership assets, the court finds the Receiver's motion to seal to be adequately supported. *See In Re Knight Pub'n Co.*, 743 F.2d 231 (4th Cir. 1984). It is accordingly

that the Receiver's motion for leave to file financial statements for the month ending December 31, 2003, the year ending December 31, 2003, and the month ending January 31, 2004 under seal shall be, and hereby is, GRANTED.
