

Before the court is the Receiver's Notice of Filing of Financial Statements and Motion to File Under Seal, filed May 6, 2004. The Receiver files these financial statements in compliance with earlier orders of the court. Having carefully weighed the First Amendment right of access to public documents against the need to protect the specific information about receivership assets, the court finds the Receiver's motion to seal to be adequately supported. *See In Re Knight Pub'n Co.*, 743 F.2d 231 (4th Cir. 1984). It is accordingly

ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED,

that the Receiver's motion for leave to file financial statements under seal for the month and year ending December 31, 2004, is hereby GRANTED. The Clerk of the Court is hereby instructed to file these statements under seal.

The Clerk of the Court is also directed to send a certified copy of this Order to all counsel of record.
